I like to use a nice warm flannel to wipe my face.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He pai ki a au kia mahana te tāora iti hei horoi i taku kanohi.</li> </ul>
It's better for your gums to brush your teeth from top to bottom, rather than round and round.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He pai ake mō ō pae/pūniho ki te paraihetia e koe ō niho mai i runga ki raro tēnā i te huri porowhita.</li> </ul>
Let's use the floss to flick out all the gunk in between.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Anei/Me tiki te miro niho hei tīkape maramara mā tāua i ō niho.</li> </ul>
Look! Your teeth are nice and shiny.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ira/Ina! Kei te pīataata katoa ō niho.</li> </ul>
I'll just go and run the bath for you.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kua haere au ki te whakakī i te tāpu mōu.</li> </ul>
Hold the brush in your right hand and pull it through your hair.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kia mau te paraihe ki tō ringa katau, ka kukume ai i ō makawe.</li> </ul>
Tuck your hair behind your ears to keep it out of the way.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Me mea/meinga ō makawe ki muri o ō taringa kia kore ai e pōrearea.</li> </ul>
Tuck in your top so it's nice and tidy.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tō hāte ki roto i tō tarau/panekoti kia pai ai tō āhua.</li> </ul>
Wipe your bottom really well.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kia pai/tika tō whērū i tō tou.</li> </ul>
When you've finished, remember to flush the toilet.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ka mutu ana koe, kei wareware koe ki te tuku i te wai.</li> <li>• Kia mutu koe, tukuna te wai (o te heketua/wharepaku).</li> </ul>
Put your shoes on.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kuhuna ō hū.</li> <li>• Komohia ō hū.</li> </ul>
Your shoes are on the wrong feet.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kei te hē kē ō hū.</li> </ul>
Push your foot right in.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Peia whakamuatia tō waewae.</li> </ul>
I'll teach you to tie your laces. Make two big loops, wrap one around the other, push it through the hole in the middle, and pull.
